Your team handicap yardage is the average of total weeks minus the first and last week's scores. These yardages will be posted on Saturday night. Scoring is on a total of 500 targets per team within each division

Alternates will be drawn at random for the teams unable to fill a full squad of regular members. A regular member is considered as one who has shot not less than 1/3 of the season (7 weeks). Since one cannot shoot for a match against their team alternates will be drawn from outside their division.

Trap Assignments:

Last place teams in each division will be the first squads out on Sunday. 25 targets per trap and rotate as in a normal league night then shoot another 25 targets per trap.
