All members should shoot the 100 targets.

Your **Shoot off yardage** is the average of all season minus the first and last weeks. Yardages will be posted on Saturday night.

Scoring is on the total of 500 targets per team within each division.

Alternates (maximum of 2) will be drawn at random for the teams unable to fill a squad of regular members. A **“regular member”**

is one who has shot not less than 1/3 of the season (7 weeks).

Since one cannot shoot against their own team, alternates will be drawn from outside the division.

Shooting Schedule:

Last place teams in each division will be up first at 11:00 am on Sunday. You will shoot 25 targets then move to the second trap.

After all teams in the division have shot their first 50 targets, the rotation will start again on the same traps for the last 50.

Trap Assignments:

Two pays per Division. Hi-Gun split 60%-40%,

A 3-4

B 5-6

C 7-8

Don't forget, each team has a required chore and we need everyone pitching in to make this a successful and fun shoot.
